- No grease, wastewater, food debris, ice water, chemicals, or other waste may be discharged onto the Fairgrounds. The operator must keep the assigned area clean and remove all property and waste as directed.
- The application does not guarantee acceptance, location, electrical service, exclusivity, attendance, sales, or results. Menu duplication may occur unless the written acceptance notice states otherwise.
- The operator must arrive, pass required inspections, be ready before opening, remain open during required service hours, follow event and Fairgrounds instructions, and not leave or close early without approval.
- Final acceptance, payment deadlines, cancellation terms, insurance limits, health and fire documentation, setup procedures, and operating rules will be stated in the acceptance notice and event rules.
